Below is a simple guideline that all consumers should use when shopping for good-quality Cannabis each time.

Start with Appearance

A good way to determine whether Cannabis is of good quality is to examine it closely. Quality cannabis buds are usually bright in color, properly trimmed, and have very small, crystal-like structures known as trichomes.

Quality cannabis buds generally look fresh, dense, and not overly dry or brown. While cannabis' appearance is not the only factor in determining its quality, it can provide a strong first impression of how well it was grown and processed.

Pay Attention to the Aroma

Cannabis has a unique and distinctive smell. Depending upon the type, Cannabis can range from a very sweet, fruity/citrus smell to a very earthy or sweet smell.

Generally speaking, a strong or pleasant-smelling strain indicates that the terpenes within the strain were preserved properly, and therefore will influence both the flavour and effects of the strain. However, if the strain has little to no aromatic qualities or has an aromatic quality of a musty texture, it may not be classified as part of a true [Premium Cannabis Selection](#).

Check the Trichomes

Trichomes are the small, crystal-like glands that form on cannabis plants (flowers). They contain cannabinoids and terpenes, the two primary chemical compounds in Cannabis. Trichome size or density are among the best indicators of quality.

When looking at cannabis flowers, you will want to find those buds that look sparkling or frosty - if a cannabis bud has a good amount of trichome material, this may be an indication that it was grown well and handled properly.

Review Lab Testing Information

A reputable brand or dispensary creates lab-tested products. Lab testing verifies the product's potency and checks for any chemical contamination (pesticides, mold) as well as solid contaminants (lead, mercury).

When buying Cannabis, it is wise to look for lab testing reports to ensure you're purchasing high-quality cannabis products from a reputable source.

Consider Freshness

Fresh weed tastes more flavorful, smells nicer, and is a more enjoyable experience than dried weed. Check the date of manufacture for all products you purchase, and don't buy anything that has been on the shelf for a long time.

If your weed has been stored correctly, it should have a slight stickiness but not much moisture. If your buds are really dry, they will lose their potency and flavor over time.

Buy from Trusted Dispensaries

Where you purchase your items should depend on the quality of the establishment you are buying from. Well-established dispensaries like Gas and Grass are built on providing high-quality products from good vendors.

A good independent wholesale source will carry a wide range of cannabis products and provide customers with high-quality information so they can make the right decision when purchasing.

Read Reviews and Recommendations

Reviews from customers can tell others about the consistency, flavor, and effectiveness of products, but all people have different tastes. Products with higher ratings are more likely to be worth buying.
